WATER SAVING TIPS

Fix Lonks Quickly

DO YOU KNOW?

The average person in Brunei Darussalam uses 420 litres of water each day for all uses. The average price for water in Brunei Darussalam is \$0.11/m or \$0.11/1000 litres.

\$0.11/1000 litres x 420 litres in one day = \$0.05

The average market price for a big bottle of mineral water (1.5 litres pack) is about \$0.80.

Our average daily usage of 420 litres per person it equivalent to 280 big bottles of mineral water. The price of 280 bottles of mineral water is 280 x \$0.80 = \$224.00 compared to \$0.05


